INTRODUCTION : Few words about the college :

The SSM Mahavidyalaya came into being in 1991 when the long cherished dream of the local farsighted people for a higher educational institution translated into reality. It was the memorable month of November 1991 when the maiden academic session underwent with a single faculty of Arts under a thatched roof in the premises of the then Nalirpar - Bhatkuchi High School.

The Mahavidyalaya is a rural college and affiliated to Gauhati University. It has been imparting higher education in one program i.e. Under Graduate (UG). The college is preparing itself for first cycle of NAAC accreditation by the end of this year.

Course of study : FYUGP (Four years under Graduate programme :

FYUGP in the Semester Scheme

Four years undergraduate program in compliance with National Education Policy- 2020 has been introduced from the Academic Session 2023-2024. The FYUGP is designed to cater to the diverse academic needs of the students and seeks to offer multiple Entries/Exits and obtain a certificate or a Diploma or a Degree with or without major or a Degree Honors with Research at various levels as stipulated under the Policy.

Salient Features of the FYUGP

❑ **Duration: The FYUGP is a four year program**

❑ **Exits/Entries :-**

Under CBCS, one needs to complete the full 3 years program in order to get a Degree. There is no provision for dropping out of the program in the middle. While in the FYUGP, one has the choice to exit from the program thrice – after one year, after two years and after three years.

If one exits one year after the program one gets a certificate and if one exits after two years one gets a Diploma on completion of one vocational course of four credits during the summer vacation of the respective year. After three years one gets a Bachelors' Degree. Finally if a student completes the whole four years he gets a Bachelors' Degree (Honors).

After an exit either after one year or two the student can seek an entry only into the same program to which the student was admitted.

When a student exit after three years with a Bachelors' Degree, he/she cannot seek re-entry into the program at the fourth year rather he/she will need to take admission into the Masters' Program at the first year.

As the Contents/Syllabi of all the courses are subject to modifications from time to time, when a student makes a re-entry into the program after an earlier exit, the student will have to follow the contents of all courses as per the syllabi at the current point of time.

❑ **First Year (Semester I & II)**

In the first year one needs to study two different Core subjects- one paper of each subject per semester, anyone of which needs to be chosen one as Core Course(Core-1) and other one as Minor subject (Core - 2). Besides one need to study a host of common subjects from the list given below :-

VAC- Value Added Course AEC- Ability Enhancement Course
SEC- Skill Enhancement Course INT- Internship
IDC- Interdisciplinary Course REM- Research Methodology

Note: AEC subjects- English & Assamese. English is compulsory for Sem-I & II

❑ **Second year (Semester III & IV)**

(Semester III) :- In continuation with the same core subjects already chosen in the first year, one will also take a step forward to study the favorite subject by declaring one of the core subjects as a major subject and other is minor.

(Semester IV) :- In the fourth Semester one will have the option of changing the major subject which was chosen in the Semester- III and other one remain as minor subject.

❑ **Third Year (Semester V & VI)**

In the third year, one will continue to study the major subjects to complete a full set of fifteen (15) in Majors.

❑ **Fourth Year**

If one intends to progress to the Fourth year he/she will be devoting the time in studying Advanced Courses which will be at the level of initial Master's Degree Papers. Besides, one will also have the opportunity of engaging into research work with the faculty members.

❑ **Details of Semester Session :**

A) Admission of Odd Semester (1st, 3rd & 5th) – June

Classes of Odd Semester- 1st August

Sessional Examination – October

End Semester Exam – November--December

Semester Break – Up to January 18th

B) Even Semester (2nd, 4th & 6th)

Classes of Even Semester- 19th January

Sessional Examination – April

End Semester Exam – May - June

Semester Break – July

❑ **Important Information for students**

Performance of the students shall be monitored throughout the semester by continuous assessment in the theory and practical course. Evaluation of the students' performance in both theory and practical paper will be based on the following criteria :-

Core Course :-

Internal Evaluation : 40% marks

External Evaluation : 60% marks

Common Course :-

Internal Evaluation: 20% marks

External Evaluation: 60% marks

Internal evaluation will be based on Sessional Examination, Home Assignment, Group Discussions and library work in each semester. External evaluation will be done through final examination under Bhattadev University Program at the end of each semester. In each paper students must have to secure pass marks for both internal and external evaluation.

The students have to attend all conducted classes throughout the week spanning from Monday to Saturday and all credits will be calculated on weekly basis as follows :-

1 Credit = 1 Hour of Theory class

Or 1 Credit = 2 Hours of Practical class

The theory class can be any of (i) A Teaching class in a classroom

(ii) A Tutorial class or Assignments

The practical class can be either (i) A Practical class conducted in a laboratory or

(ii) A Project work

However class attendance must be at least 75% (for male & 70% for female) of the classes throughout the semester, less than that shall debar a student from appearing in the final examination as a regular student. Apart from regular classes Tutorial classes will be held segregating the students into several groups if required.

❑ **Admission Procedure :**

Procedure of admission into all courses begins with the Opening of the Samarth Portal of State Govt. of Assam for the students of B.A. First Semester. The students will have to take admission through Samarth portal only and choose the college in which they are intending to get admission. The admission website is (<https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in>) for B.A. First Sem. On acceptance of admission through Samarth portal, the students will have to submit the admission form generated from the portal along with all necessary particulars and fee to the principal of the college already chosen.

The students, who want to take admission under the fee waiver scheme of the State Govt. of Assam, shall have to produce an Income Certificate from the Circle Officer or BPL ration card showing their annual income not more than Rupees two lacs.

Students belonging to SC, ST & OBC category shall have to submit their caste certificate along with the application form.

The students whose parent's annual income exceeds more than rupees two lacs shall not be covered by the fee waiver scheme. They shall have to pay the fee in full as shown below -

❑ **ELIGIBILITY NORMS**

The eligibility norms for submission of applications for admission into course are as follows :

1. FYUGP (Arts) : HS or equivalent examination passed in any stream.

❑ **DOCUMENTS FOR ADMISSION**

Admission forms must be submitted with the following supporting documents/particulars:

- (i) Self-Attested copies of all certificates and Marks sheets.
- (ii) Students belonging to SC, ST, OBC/MOBC/PWD/OSP must have to enclose certificate of respective caste. (if any).
- (iii) Gap certificate from competent authority, if required.
- (iv) Students from other than the State of Assam shall have to produce migration certificates at the time of admission.

❑ **CANCELLATION OF ADMISSION**

A student failing to attend classes for 30 days at a stretch, his/her admission shall be cancelled.

❑ **ACADEMIC REGULATIONS**

The Mahavidyalaya follows the regulations prepared by Bhattadev University which is also the subject of change from time to time in respect of concerned courses.

❑ **FACILITIES AVAILABLE**

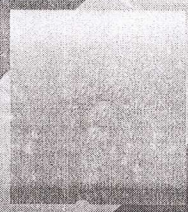
